Sunflower maze in iowa

Harvestville Farm is THRILLED to once again host our Very Popular 2nd Annual Sunflower Festival for the 2020 Season! Our first sunflower festival last year was a success and exceeded all our expectations! We expect the 2020 festival to once again be a memorable event! The Sunflower Festival will take place on the following dates - PLEASE NOTE THE DATE CHANGE - Due to the Mother Nature Festival will now begin Thursday, August 13 at 10:00 am. All guests are invited to take as many photos as they wish of our recently expanded seven-acre sunflower field with their families and friends. Our sunflowers vary in height and color, allowing families to have a wide range of photo options with young children, teenagers and adults. Psst... There will be several photo prop areas throughout the field this year! The festival will also feature LIVE music from Tim Smith, on Sunday August 16th from 1pm to 4pm and Saturday August 22 from 1pm to 4pm, along with concession style food served from The Pitchfork Café on every festival day from 11am to 3pm. The entrance fee for the festival is \$7.00 per person and will be required for admission by all guests (Children 2 years and under is free) and includes: Unlimited photo opportunities in seven acres of Sunflower Field, access to it cut your own sunflower fields and family time in both play areas – Inflatable, Tire Pyramids, Trike Tracks, Rubber Ducky Races, Giant Slide, Horse and Tractor Swings, Wiggle Cars, Flying Turtles, Playhouse, General Store, Workshop, Corn Hole, Human Hamster Wheels, Hay Bale Jumps, Tether Balls, Pumpkin Bowling, DragFight, Giant Chess, Giant Checkers & Giant Scrabble and Jump Pumpkin - NEW Activities Coming this year --

Professional photographers are also welcome to this popular event using Harvestville Farm as the background/setting for any portrait/commercial photography. A Day Pass or a Season Pass is required for professional photographers only and needs to be done online [HERE](#) before their visit. We will not sell Day Pass or Season Pass by phone or facebook. Absolutely NO sessions after business hours. Each guest, scheduled with a professional photographer, must also pay the \$7.00 entrance fee associated with the festival. (Children 2 years and under is free) Professional Portrait Photography is defined as, but not limited to: senior photos, engagement, family, graduation, wedding, etc. Professional commercial photography is defined as, but not limited to: catalog, fashion, advertising, marketing, etc. Professional Photography Fee – A one Day Pass shooting in the yard is \$75 per day. Professional photographers can schedule as many photo sessions as they choose during business hours that day. Season pass for professional photographer - Professional Photographer Season Pass for the farm is \$175 and is great for the Sunflower Festival through 2020 Autumn and Christmas. Guests are welcome to bring their own buckets and clippers. Remember that sunflowers have thick stems so suitable clippers will be needed. PLEASE NOTE: Pets are NOT allowed on our farm for the safety of all our guests and staff, which includes personal and professional photo shoots. Registered service dogs are allowed. NOTE: Sunflowers are an agricultural crop and therefore subject to weather, growing conditions and maturation variables. We can not guarantee that the sunflowers will bloom on a specific date, so prepare to be flexible with several days of your visit. Here's the scoop on how Siouxland area families and visitors can enjoy this fun event: Sunflower Days 2020 will be every weekend in September, starting September 12th (subject to change based on weather)! Where's the Sunflower Festival? The sunflower festival is held at Scarecrow Farm in Lawton, Iowa, about 10 minutes past Sioux City Menards on Highway 20. What can you do at the Sunflower Festival? At the Sunflower Festival at Scarecrow Farm there will be a wide range of fun, including Lots of Sunflowers! The middle circle of Scarecrow Farm where pumpkins ready to buy are placed during the pumpkin season has been taken over as a sunflower field, plus there are several more acres of sunflowers in addition to it! In addition to enjoying the view and taking pictures, you can also buy sunflowers to take home with you. Food and drink for sale, turkey legs, root beer floats, chocolate bars and kettle corn farm market open to buy jam, jelly, honey, squash and other locally produced treats to take home with you How do you get tickets to the Sunflower Festival at on at Farm Fares for Sunflower Days 2020 are not yet announced. In 2019, tickets to the Sunflower Festival at Scarecrow Farm were \$11.95 (plus tax) for each person 3+ and toddlers and infants 2 or younger were free. I would foresee a similar price range for 2020, and will update when prices are announced. You can buy tickets to the Sunflower Festival at the door, but if you prefer to buy in advance, you can buy tickets on the Scarecrow Farm website soon!
